

# El Verbo IR

IR = TO GO

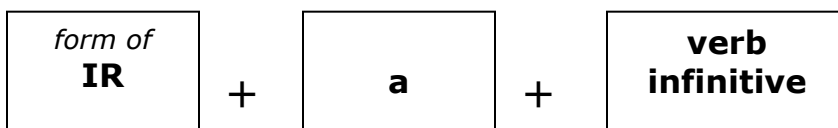
Subject Pronoun	Verb (Spanish)	Verb (English)
yo	<b>voy</b>	I go
tú	<b>vas</b>	you (familiar) go
él, ella, usted, object (singular)	<b>va</b>	he, she, object goes; you (formal) go
nosotros	<b>vamos</b>	we go
ellos, ustedes, objects (plural)	<b>van</b>	they, you all (plural), objects go

**vámanos** = let's go

- The verb **IR** is usually followed by the pronoun '**a**'.

Example: **Yo voy a la playa.** - *I'm go/I'm going to the beach.*

- To talk about the future, use the following formula:



Example: **Yo voy a estudiar para el examen.**- *I'm going to study for the test.*
