## What's a Verb Infinitive?

- A verb infinitive tells you the action, but it doesn't tell you who is doing it



## How Do You Know It's a Verb Infinitive?

- “To” in front of the verb (to speak, to eat, to live, etc.)



## Verb Infinitive

- In Spanish?
  - ar, -er, -ir at the end of the verb!

| Endings | Verb Infinitive | English Meaning |
|---------|-----------------|-----------------|
| -ar     | Hablar          | To speak        |



| Endings | Verb Infinitive | English Meaning |
|---------|-----------------|-----------------|
| -er     | Comer           | To eat          |



| Endings | Verb Infinitive | English Meaning |
|---------|-----------------|-----------------|
| -ir     | Vivir           | To live!        |

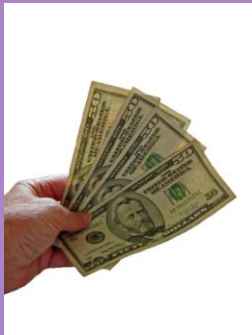

## Important -AR Verbs

| Verbo       | Meaning                |
|-------------|------------------------|
| 1. Bailar   | To dance               |
| 2. Buscar   | To look for, to search |
| 3. Cantar   | To sing                |
| 4. Comprar  | to buy                 |
| 5. Enseñar  | To teach               |
| 6. Escuchar | To listen              |
| 7. Estudiar | To study               |

## Important -AR Verbs

| Verbo         | Meaning                         |
|---------------|---------------------------------|
| 8. Hablar     | To speak, to talk               |
| 9. Necesitar  | To need                         |
| 10. Pagar     | To pay                          |
| 11. Practicar | To practice                     |
| 12. Trabajar  | To work                         |
| 13. Tomar     | To take, to drink               |
| 14. Tocar     | To touch; to play an instrument |

## Now We Conjugate! (

- **CONJUGATE** - (conjugar) to state the verb in a form that gives it a personal meaning corresponding to its subject: *I speak, you speak, he speaks*, etc.



## What Does That Mean?

- In a nutshell...
- It tells you action and also who's doing it!

## How Do We Do That en Español?

- Personal Endings! (Of Course!)
- These endings are added to the end of the verb!



But **first** you must get rid of the -ar, -er, -ir

**Hablar** •Habl-

**Comer** •Com-

**Vivir** •Viv-
